Instructions: DR650 – Oil Cooler Guard

Tools & Supplies

- 4mm hex key
- 8mm box wrench
- Steady fingers
- Blue Loctite

Step 1 Remove your existing oil cooler guard.

Keep aside the stock screws if you prefer to reuse those.

Step 2 Try to fit the new guard to your oil cooler with the guard tabs going inside the cooler tabs.

If that doesn't fit well right away, simply open the cooler tabs a little with a plier.

It's very often that these are bent. Do your best to open/straighten them so that you can fit the guard just a little tight.

We do not recommend to bend the guard itself.



Step 3 Mount the screws (stock or the new Allen supplied with the guard) using Blue Loctite and tighten them **gently**.

Be careful, because we designed a lightweight guard to prevent adding too much weight to the cooler, the threads are delicate.

Just hands firm with Blue Loctite is all you need to keep it in place!
